
#### Chapter 5- Confucianism & Daoism

#### Confucius


 <u>Confucius</u> was a Chinese scholar and philosopher from around 500 BCE who wanted to bring <u>peace</u> and <u>order</u> to China.





# Philosophy

- <u>Confucianism</u> is the <u>philosophy</u> started by Confucius.
- A <u>philosophy</u> is someone's <u>basic beliefs about</u> the way people should live.



#### Confucianism

- According to Confucianism, people must respect each other and follow a code of conduct.
- Respect must be shown to <u>family members</u> and between <u>government</u> officials and people.



#### Confucianism

• Above all, children were always supposed to respect their elders. This is called <u>Filial Piety</u>.

# Confucianism brings order

 Confucianism helped the Chinese <u>avoid</u> conflict and live <u>peacefully</u>.

#### Daoism

 Another ancient philosophy in Ancient China, called "<u>Daoism</u>" says that people must learn to <u>live in harmony</u>, or agreement, with <u>nature</u> and their <u>feelings</u>.
